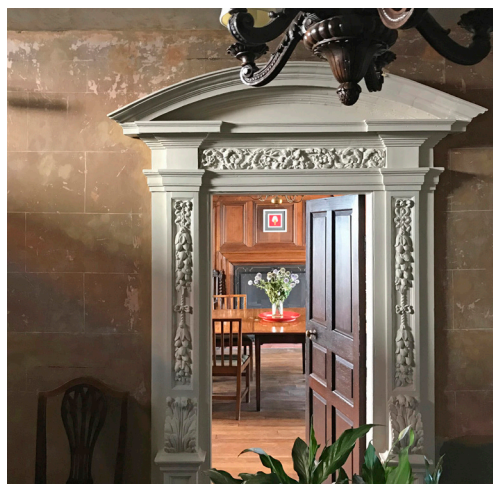

# Bridlington Old Town

## 10-11 & 17-18 September



Part of no.43 High Street (The Toft), a 17th century merchant's house, and its garden will be open both weekends between 10.30am & 4.30pm.

On the first Saturday, visit The Priory Rooms on Church Green to speak with local heritage and conservation groups and learn what our area has to offer.

On Applegarth Lane, Yorkshire's oldest (1698) Baptist Chapel is open on 11th and 17th, 11am to 4pm, and 18th, 1pm to 4pm.

The Priory Church is taking part the first weekend, as is St John's Burlington Methodist Church.

New event this year:

On the first weekend, by kind permission of their owners, several private High Street gardens are also taking part in the open days so that visitors can not only enjoy the beautiful gardens but also appreciate the historical aspect of the High Street's 'backside'.
